



Covid19 Statement

COVID19 (Coronavirus) precautions are in place for all training and delivery across MyneSight Offices and client workplaces in accordance with the practices outlined by the Australian Government Department of Health.

Our students are required to undertake a COVID-19 pre assessment prior to undertaking any training in a MyneSight office or a client location. Students are required to sign a declaration upon arrival to their course – this is also required for bookings taken online.

If a student is sick and think they have symptoms of COVID-19, they must;

- Seek medical advice
- call MyneSight prior to their course starts
- Do not attend training until they are well.

MyneSight has the safety measures in place, at our training locations as per the QLD and NSW Government requirements;

Hygiene resources provided, at our training locations include but are not limited to;

- Hand sanitiser
- Tissues
- Gloves.

It is required that all staff/students practice good hygiene, including:

- Frequent hand washing
- Limiting contact with others, including through shaking hands
- Covering mouth in the event of coughing or sneezing
- If a staff member identifies a student is unwell, student to leave the premises immediately and reschedule training later.

The above also applies to staff members and Trainers from MyneSight.

For training conducted in the workplace, persons are required to adhere to Covid19 safety practices and measures implemented by their employers. MyneSight representatives, concerned about the health and safety of persons during training in the workplace, may cease the training until additional safety measures have been undertaken.
